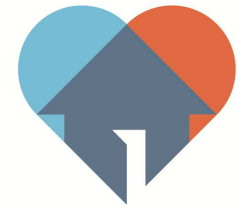

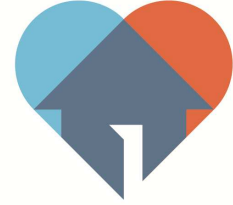

A Way Home America: Our Goal

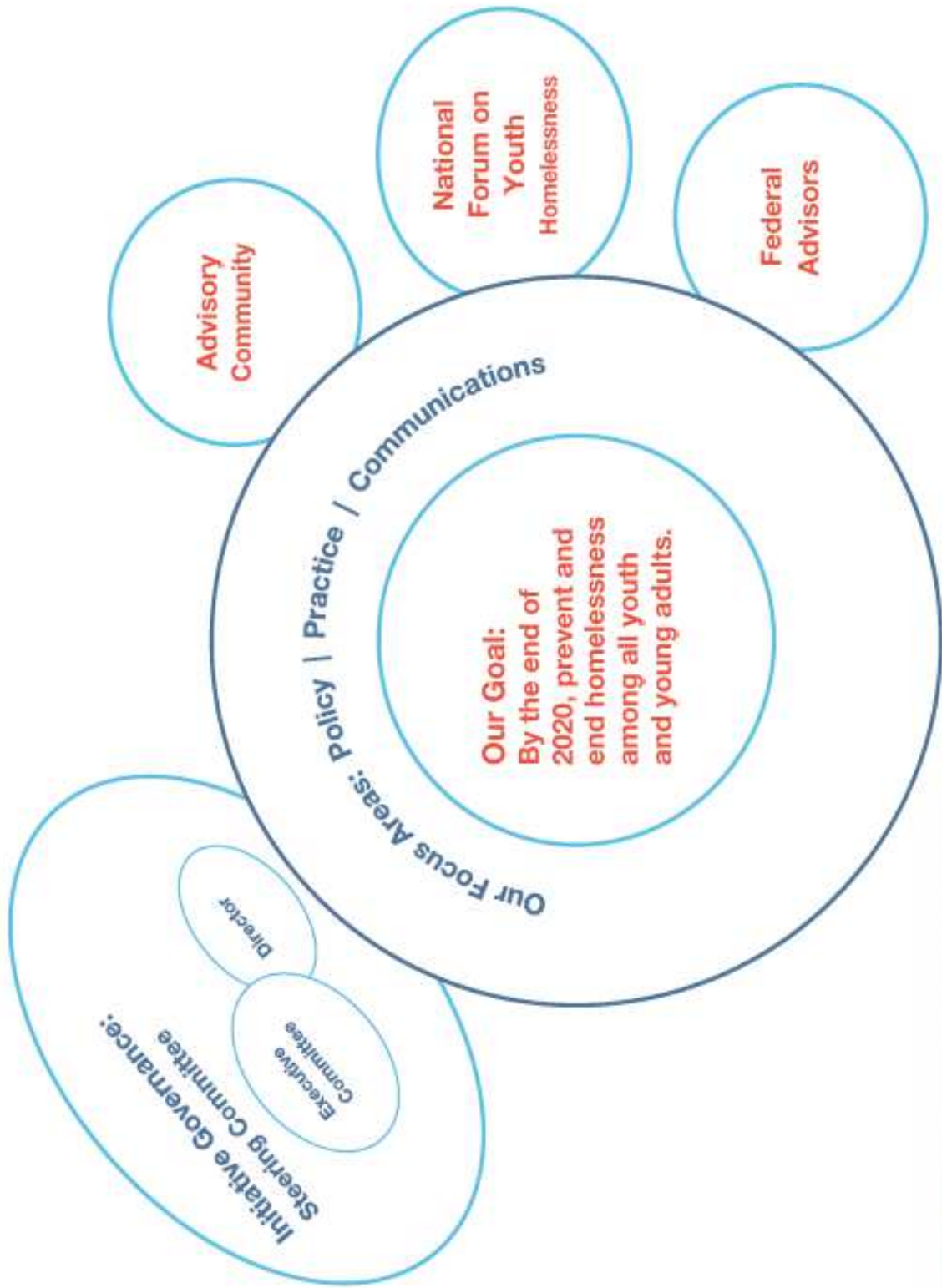

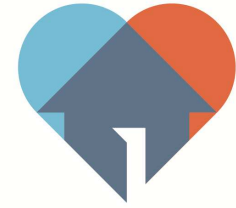
Who We Are

- **National Forum on Youth Homelessness who offer their insight and strategy from lived experiences of homelessness**



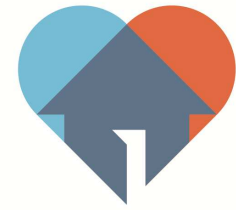
Our Work

- **Elevate the issue of youth homelessness nationally.**

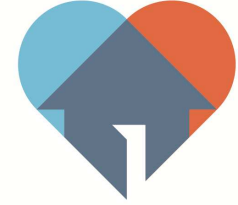
