

## HELPING THE UNSHELTERED IS ESSENTIAL

As federal COVID-19 relief is spent in states and communities, they can not be left behind.

Even before the pandemic, unsheltered homelessness had been surging.



**30%** increase in unsheltered homeless. The unsheltered population has risen dramatically since 2015, nearly erasing a decade of work.

 ~209,000
individuals (not living in families with children) were unsheltered in 2020.
This is a record high number.

Every race, ethnicity, gender and age group (except for children) is affected.
