MANDATORY COVID-19 Vaccination Policy FOR EVENTS

Purpose

In response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the National Alliance to End Homelessness (“the Alliance”) has adopted the following policy (“Policy”) to safeguard the health and well-being individuals attending the Alliance meetings and Events (“Event(s)”) and the communities in which Events are held from infectious conditions that may be mitigated through an effective COVID-19 vaccination program. This Policy is intended to comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws and is based upon guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) and public health authorities, as applicable.

Scope

As a condition of attendance at Alliance Events, individuals must be up to date with all vaccinations against COVID-19 by the first date of the Event. For purposes of this Policy, **an individual is up to date** with their COVID-19 vaccination if they have received all recommended doses in the primary series and [one booster](#) when eligible. Getting a second booster is not necessary to be considered up to date at this time.

Policy

Individuals seeking to attend Alliance Events must submit an ATTESTATION OF COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS at the time of registration for each Event. Individuals must also submit an ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR and adhere to all safety and health protocols issued by the Alliance or any federal, state, or local authorities in place at the time of the Event.

If requested by the Alliance, individuals seeking to attend the 2022 Conference on Ending Homelessness Event may be required to submit documentation and proof to support their ATTESTATION OF COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS.

Consequences of Non-Compliance

Individuals who do not comply with this Policy will be denied participation in the 2022 Conference on Ending Homelessness Event and may be removed from the event without refund of any registration fees.

Right To Change or Terminate This Policy

The Alliance may change, suspend, or revoke all or part of this Policy at any time, at its sole discretion, upon notice to Event attendees.
