What is the Opportunity?

The National Center on Homelessness Among Veterans (NCHAV) aims to promote Veteran-centered research that can inform policies, practices and approaches to prevent homelessness among Veterans. To help make our research meaningful and relevant, we have created a Veteran board comprised of people with lived-experiences with homelessness to provide input on Center-affiliated research priorities and studies.

Why Participate?

This is an opportunity to make a difference. You will collaborate with Veteran board members and Center-affiliated researchers to improve research related to Veterans' health, housing and provide real-time feedback to researchers as they develop and implement studies.

Who can Participate?

- Are you A Veteran over the age of 18?
- Have you had lived experiences of homelessness?
- Can you commit to meeting online once every two months?
- If you answered yes to ALL of these questions, you are eligible to participate with the Veteran Engagement Panel.

What does participation involve?

Participants will be asked to attend online sessions, every two months, which usually last around 90 minutes. In return a \$30 stipend will be awarded as a form of compensation.
