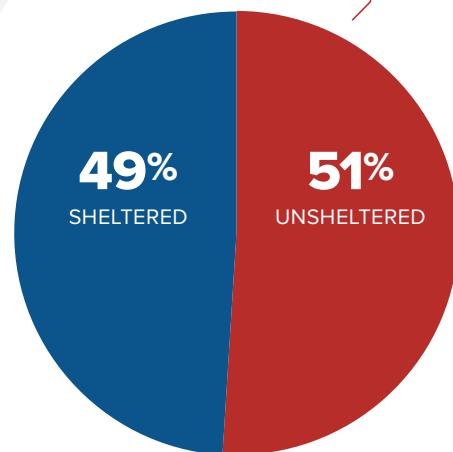
While **1,114** AR residents were permanently housed last year,

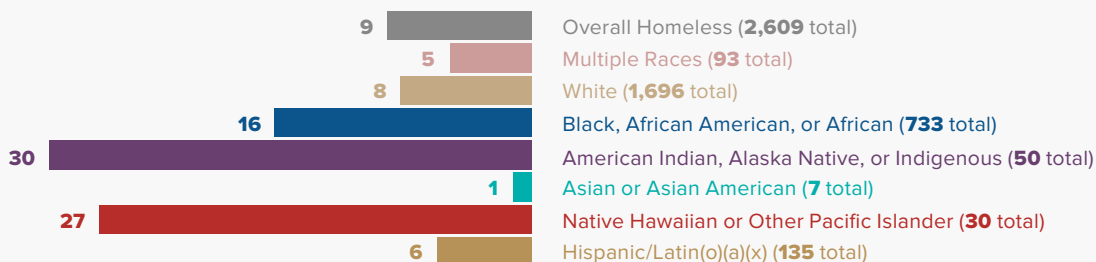
