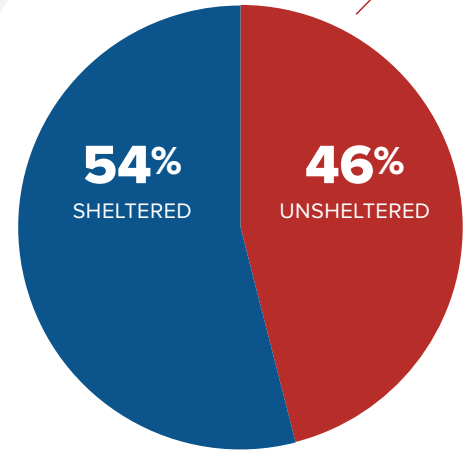
While **1,101** ID residents were permanently housed last year,

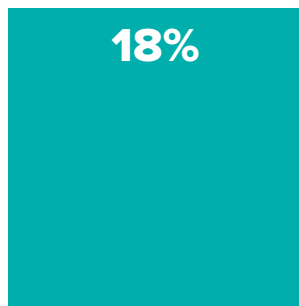

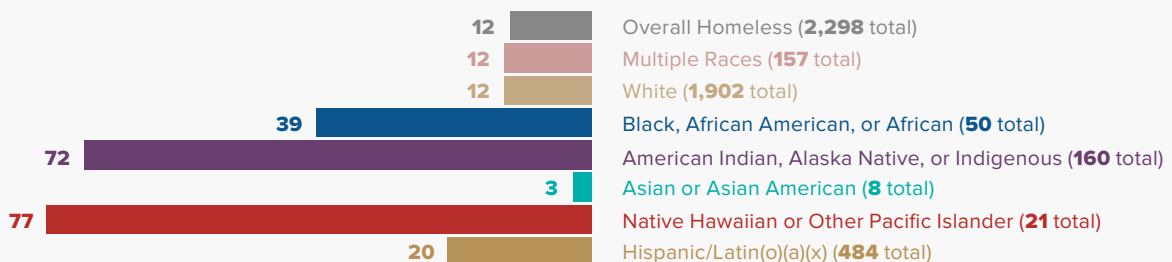
