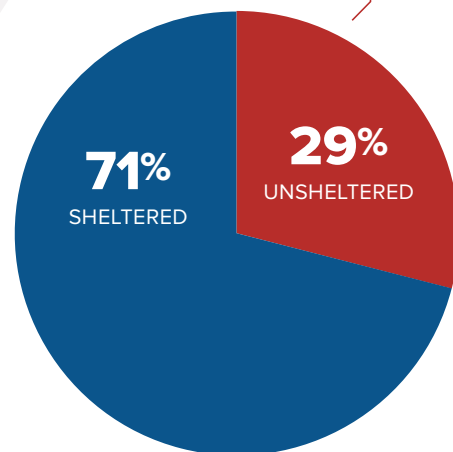
While **2,061** KS residents were permanently housed last year,

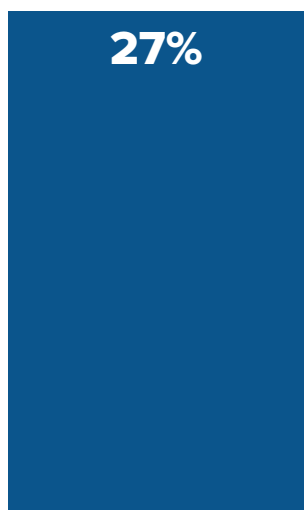

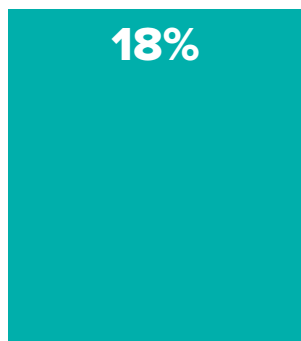

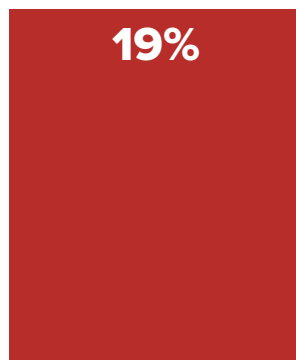

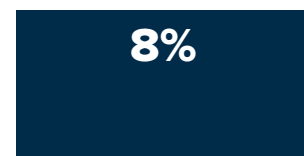

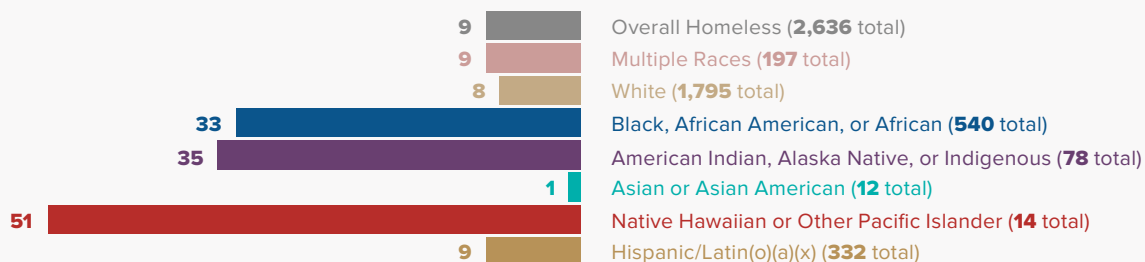
