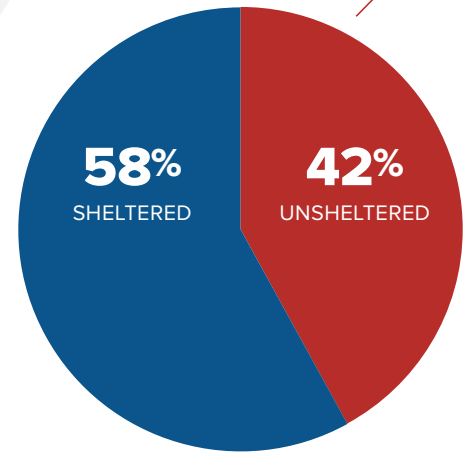
While **1,326** NM residents were permanently housed last year,

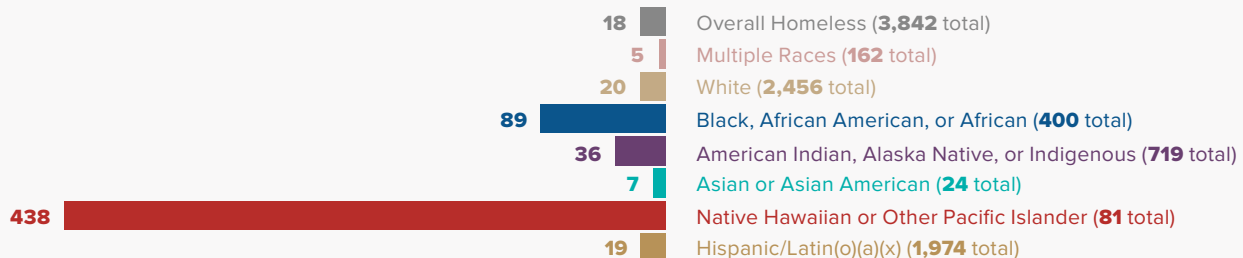
