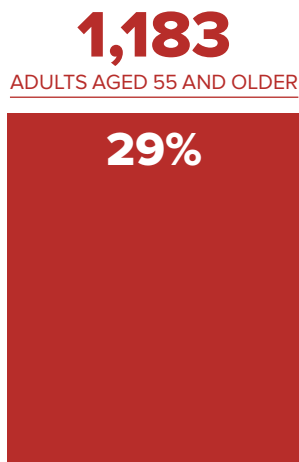
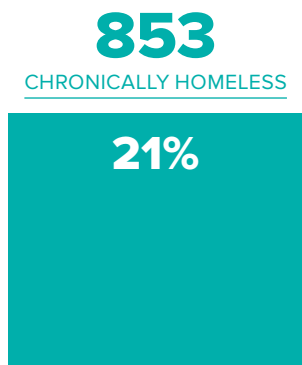
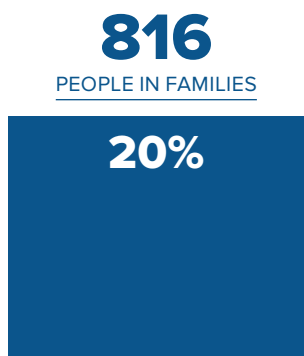
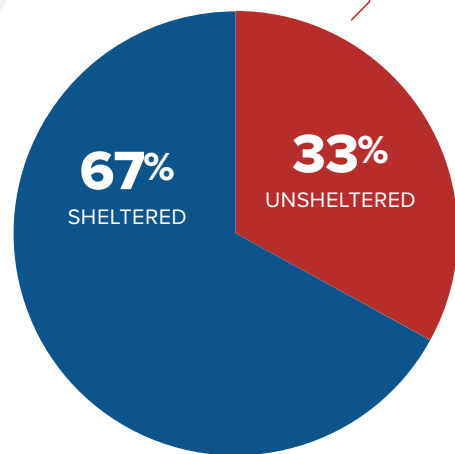


While **2,117** SC residents were permanently housed last year,



7,064 entered into homelessness.

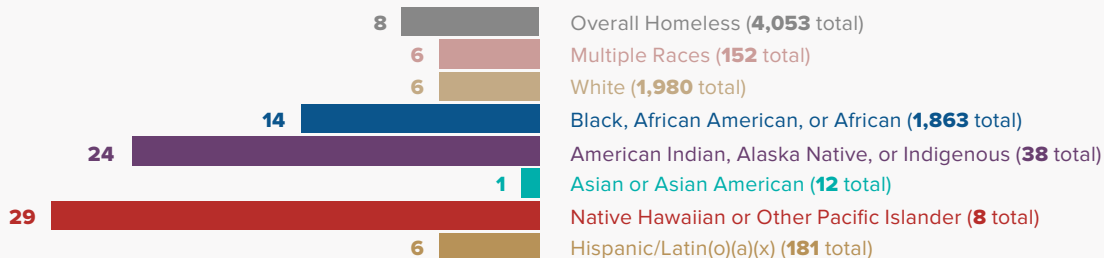
