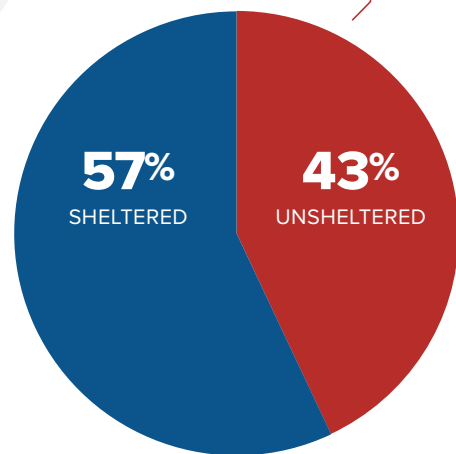
While **19,922** TX residents were permanently housed last year,

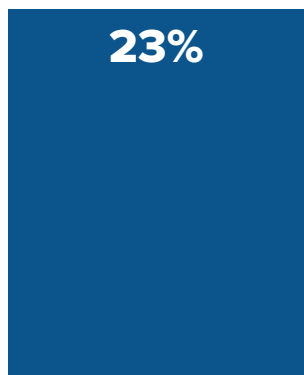

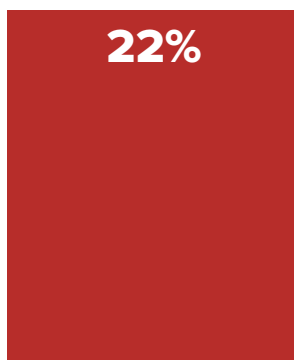

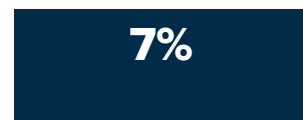

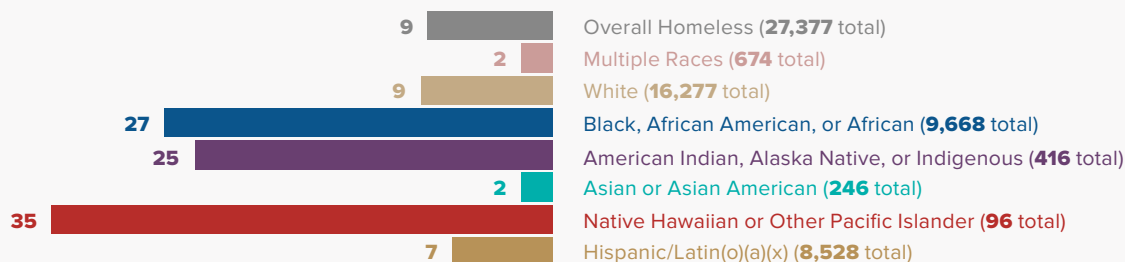
