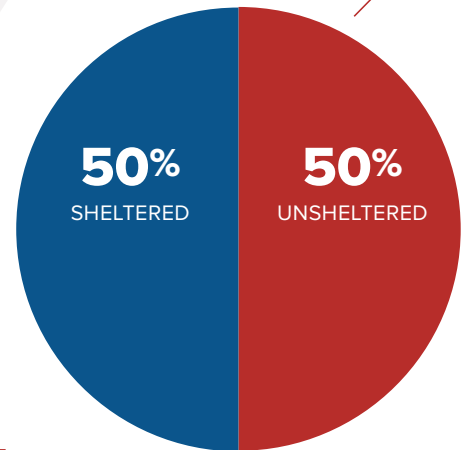
While **19,099** FL residents were permanently housed last year,

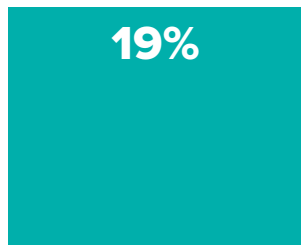

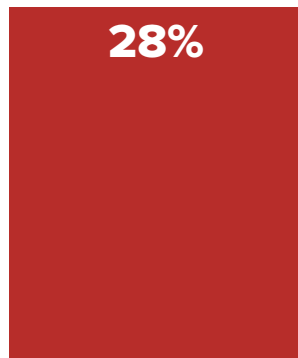

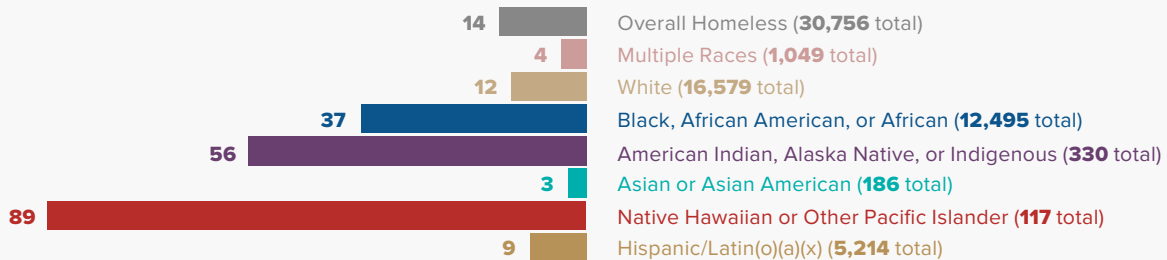
