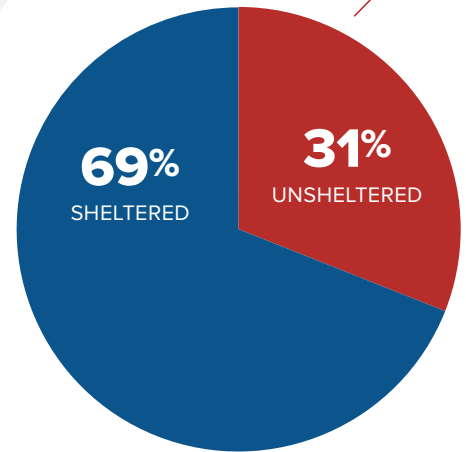
While **2,817** KY residents were permanently housed last year,

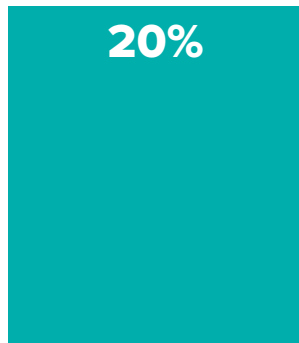

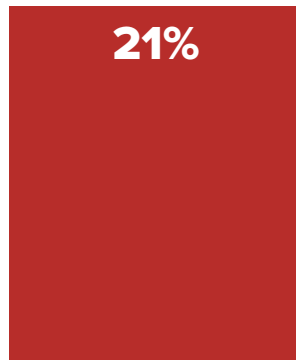

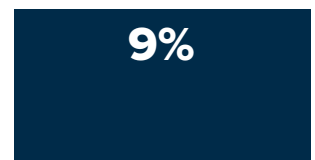

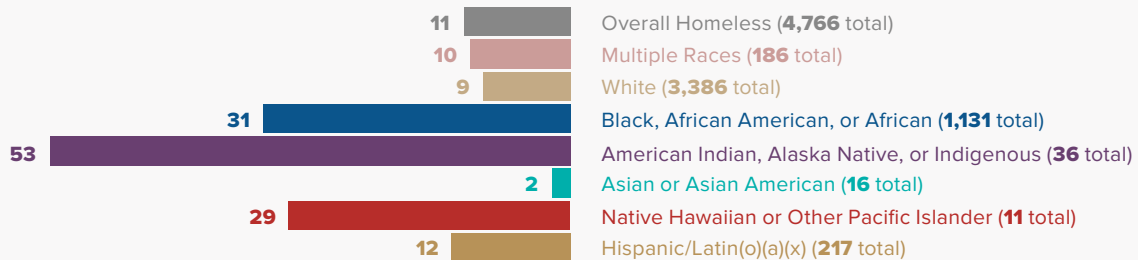
