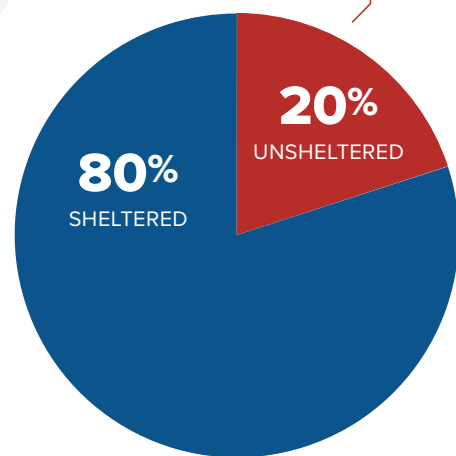
While **5,073** MN residents were permanently housed last year,

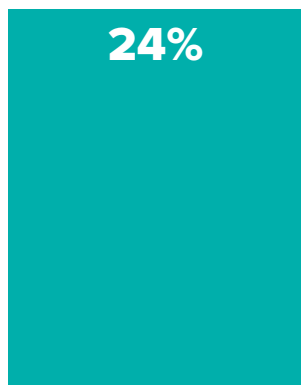

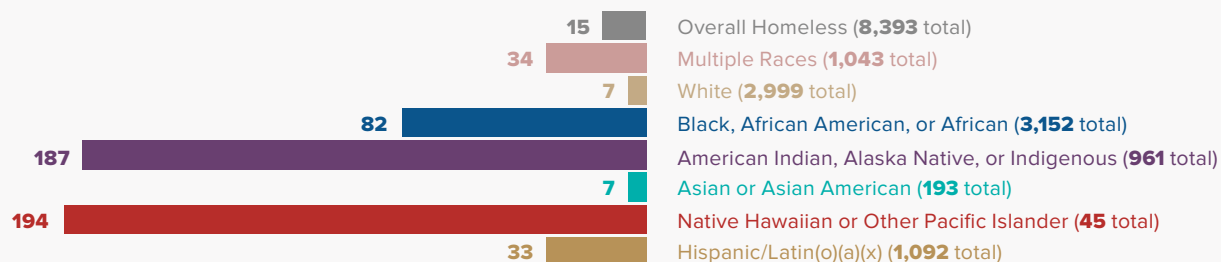
