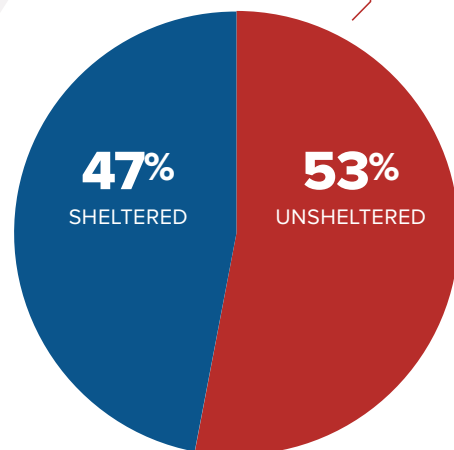
While **2,882** NV residents were permanently housed last year,

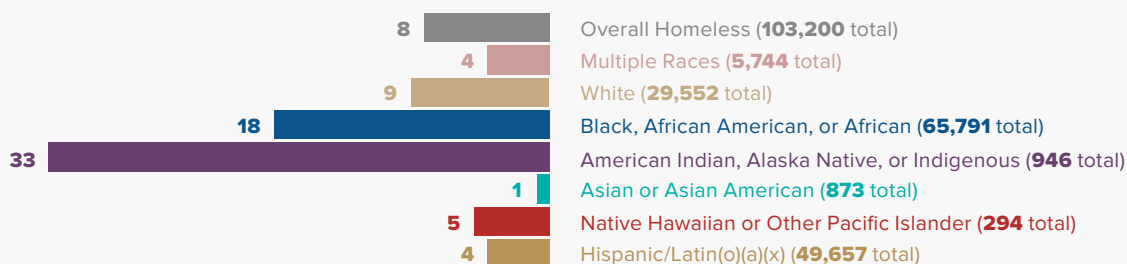
