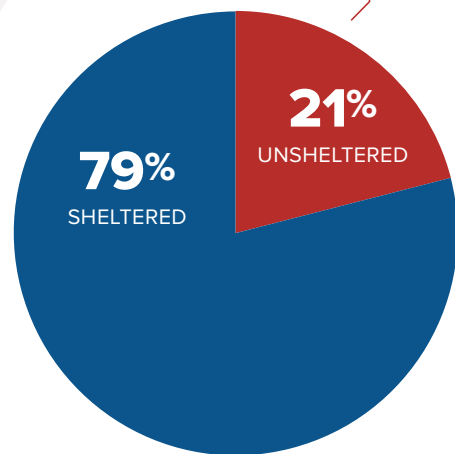
While **14,416** OH residents were permanently housed last year,

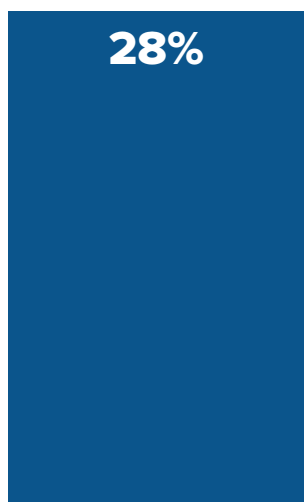

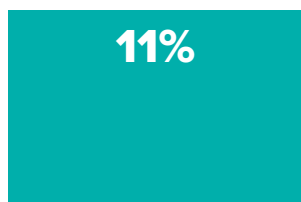

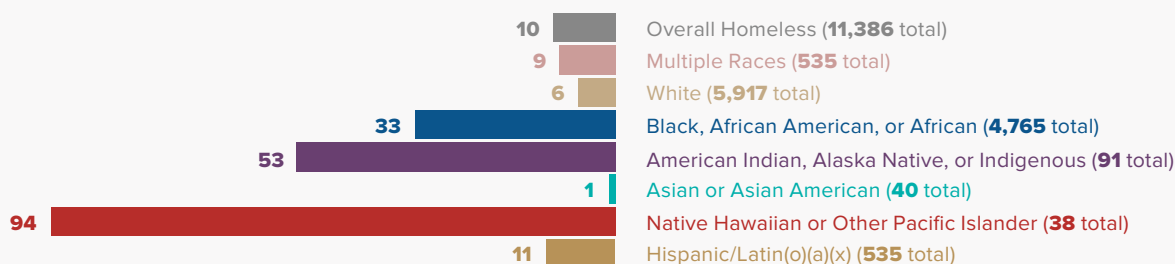
