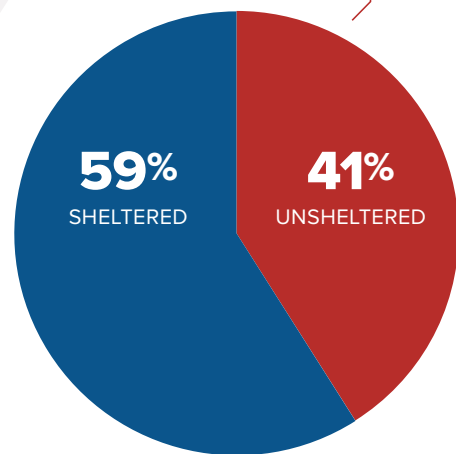
While **3,291** OK residents were permanently housed last year,

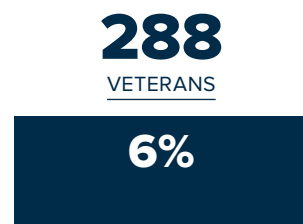
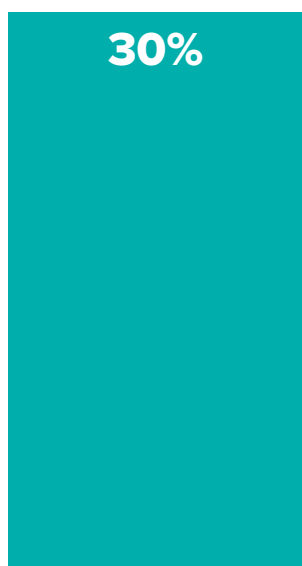
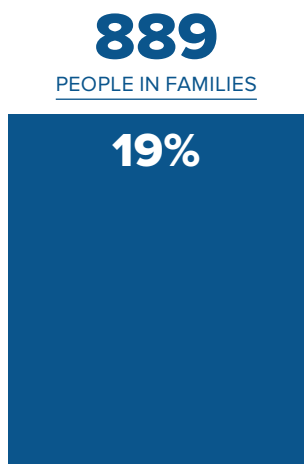

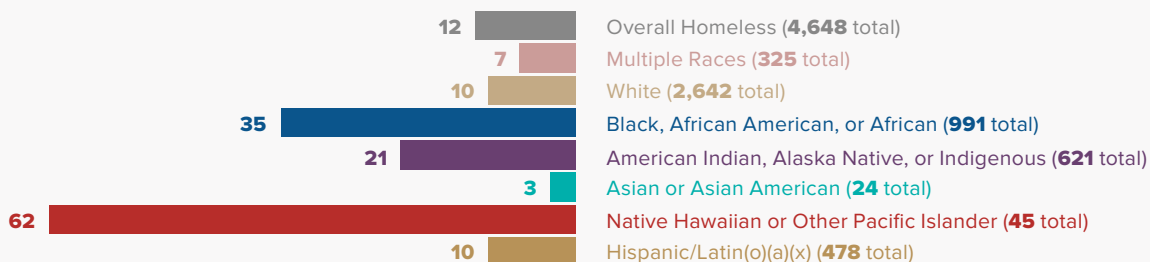
CHRONICALLY HOMELESS
