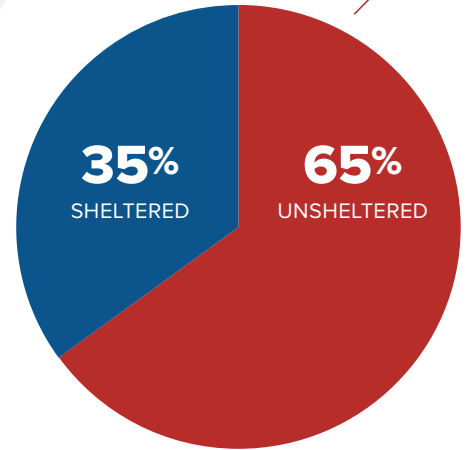
While **6,456** OR residents were permanently housed last year,

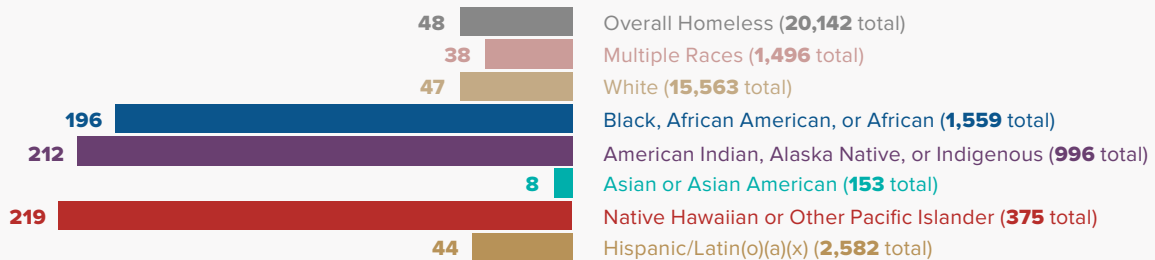
