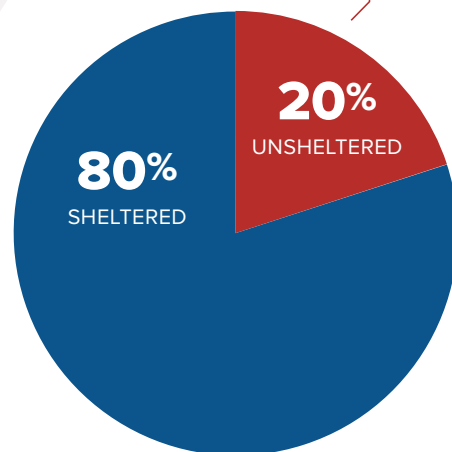
While **6,190** VA residents were permanently housed last year,

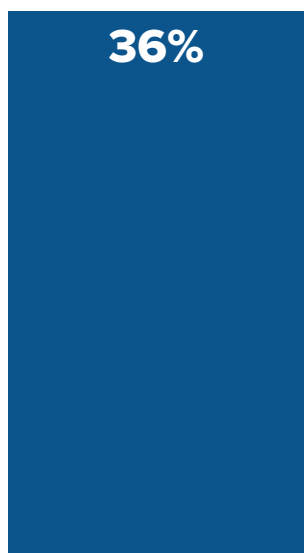

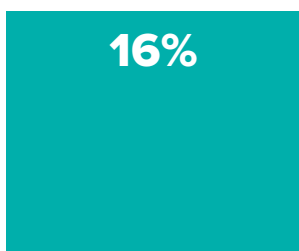

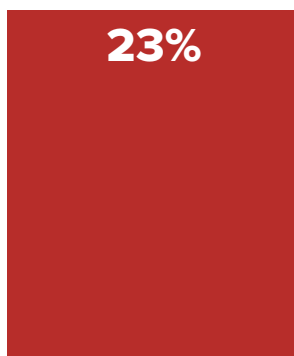

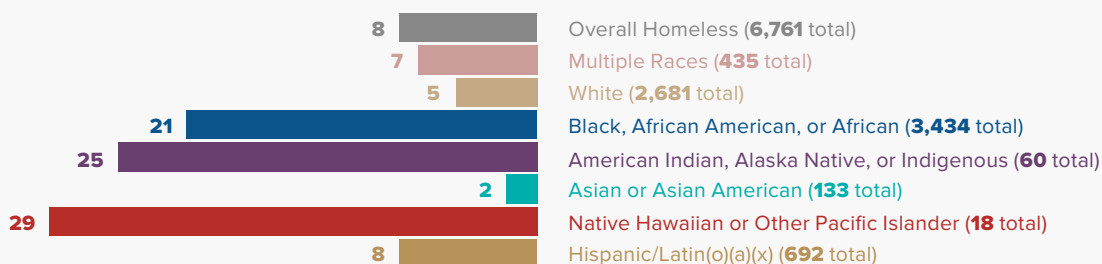
