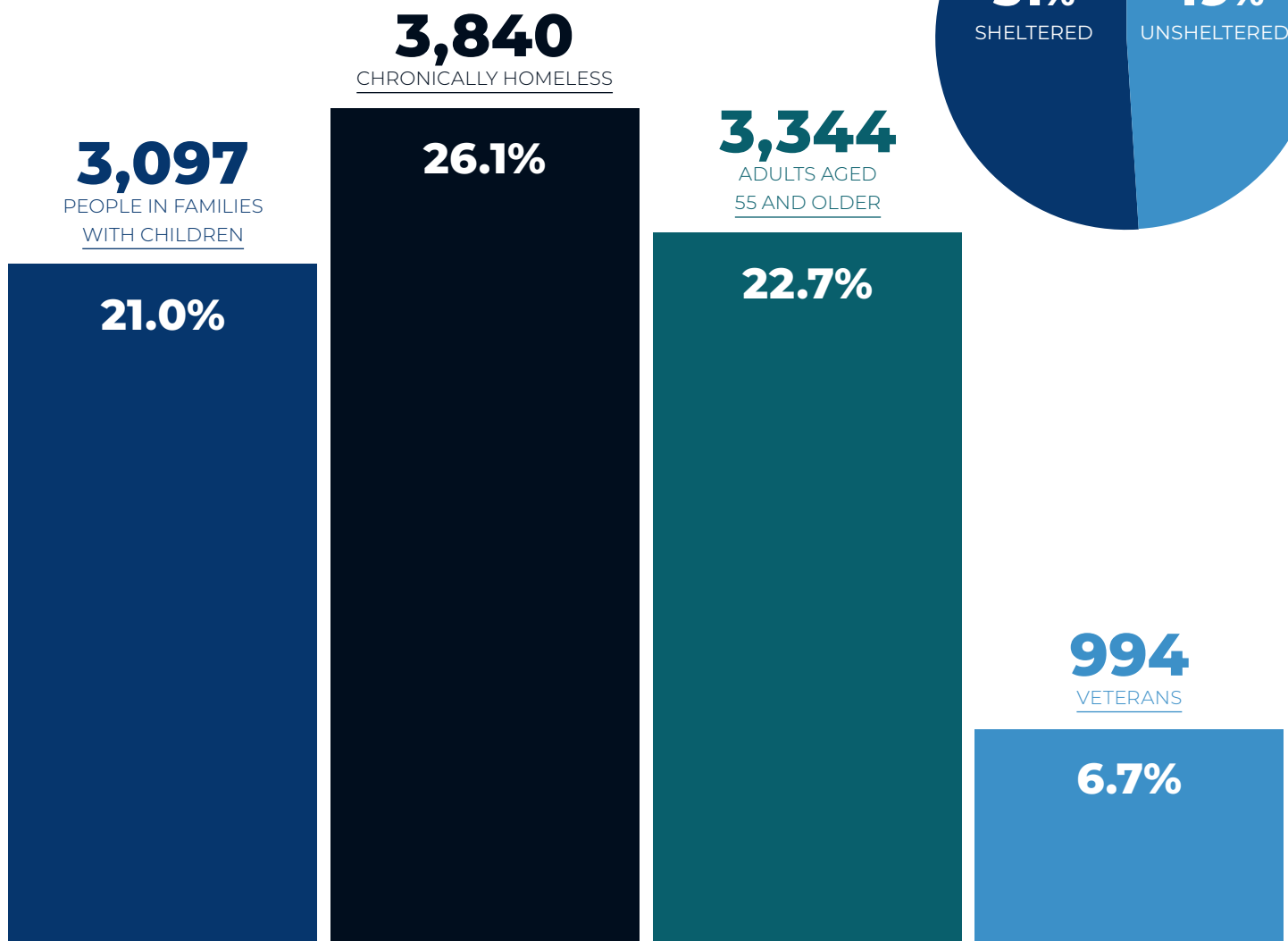
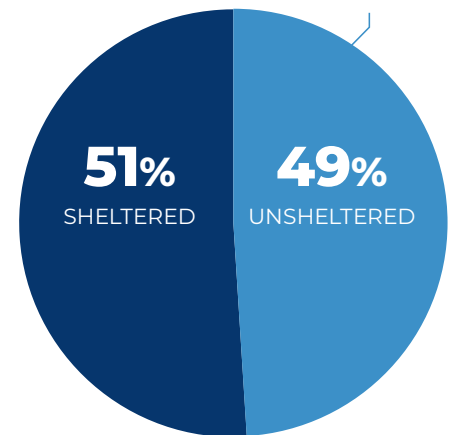
While **9,357** AZ residents were permanently housed last year,
