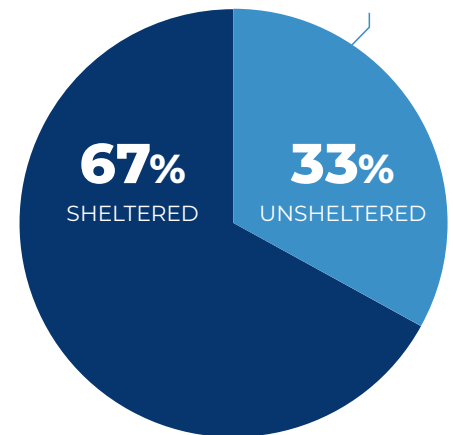
While **3,298** KY residents were permanently housed last year,
