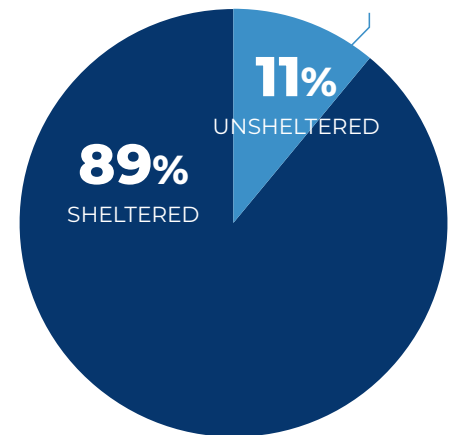
While **2,633** NE residents were permanently housed last year,
