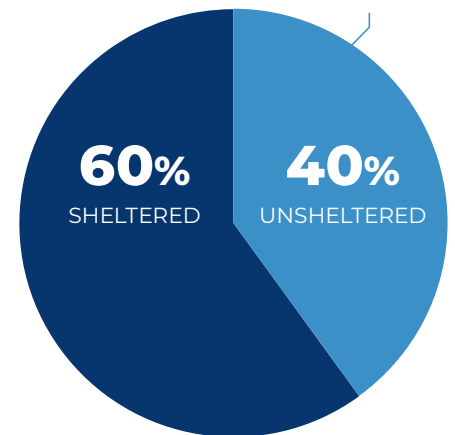
While **2,529** SC residents were permanently housed last year,
